Parental Permission Forms: If a child is not traveling with both parents or legal guardians, you must have permission forms for the child to be in the country. These forms must be in both English and Spanish.


Kid Boats: They tend to travel in packs. You may have to change your schedule for kid time. There will be times when there are no other kids... that is just the way it is.
